India to become global auto mkt leader by 2030, says Gadkari

INDIA'S AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRY will be number one in the world in the next five years, Union minister Nitin Gadkari said on Saturday, highlighting that the industry has created 45 million jobs till now, the highest in the country.

Addressing a Federation of Automobile Dealers Association (FADA) event, the road transport and highways minister further said demand of Indian automobile products is very high globally.

"The size of Indian automobile industry is now ₹2.2 lakh crore. I am confident that within five years, the Indian automobile industry will be number one in the world," he said.

Presently, size of the US automobile industry is ₹7.8 lakh crore, followed by China (₹4.7 lakh crore) and India (₹2.2 lakh crore).

Hyundai, TVS explore pact for 3&4 wheelers

HYUNDAI MOTOR COMPANY (HMC) and TVS Motor Company are exploring a collaboration for passenger three and four wheelers designed by the Korean brand and contract manufactured by the Indian company.

The concepts of these products were unveiled on Saturday at the Bharat Mobility Global Expo in New Delhi.

While no binding agreements have been explored or executed, Hyundai Motor is exploring the potential to offer design, engineering and technology, while TVS Motor will explore manufacturing and marketing of the vehicle, a statement from HMC said.

The three-wheeler passenger segment controlled by Mahindra & Mahindra, followed by Bajaj Auto and Piaggio while the four-wheeler commercial passenger vehicle segment, also called as quadricycle, only has two

Auto. However, Bajaj's Qute is powered by a petrol engine. If the two companies go ahead with production of the said products then it will mark a significant entry of a large car manufacturer like Hyundai in the micro-mobility segment.

"Collaborating with TVS Motor, we aim to locally produce

the three-wheeler while exploring global opportunities for the four-wheeler, blending innovative functionality with the spirit of a rapidly innovating India," said Vinayak Lee, executive vice president and head of Hyundai and Genesis Global Design.

"By combining Hyundai Motor's global expertise with our deep understanding of mobility solu-

tions, we aim to develop next-generation micro-mobility solutions for last-mile connectivity," said Shauro Mishra, president, Group Strategy, TVS Motor Company.

TVS has been developing its own electric three-wheelers since the past several years to challenge M&M. Its product will be available in the market in this quarter.

The electric three-wheeler concept is designed to navigate narrow streets with the height of the body being adjustable, allowing it to be lifted to navigate water-logged streets. It has a unique diagonal profile with an angled windshield which enhances collision protection.

The interior reinforces this practical focus with flexible elements, including adaptable storage solutions, a slim cluster design for intuitive information display, a dedicated phone holder to enhance connectivity, and pebbled-inspired panels that can be adjusted for convenience, hygiene and safety. Hyundai said in a release.

VinFast to launch 2 electric SUVs in India later this year

VINFAST'S ELECTRIC VEHICLE maker VinFast Auto on Saturday said its two electric SUVs — VF 7 and VF 6 — will hit the Indian market later this year to mark its foray into the country, which it says has a huge growth potential.

The company, which is investing \$500 million to set up its manufacturing plant at Tuticorin in Tamil Nadu, expects completion of the facility in the second half of 2025 after which it will launch the products.

It is also in talks with the government for its investment in India to be considered for incentives under the new EV policy and is looking to export EVs

produced in India to the West Asian and African markets.

"We hope that if (Tuticorin plant) will be completed by the end of H1 or H2 beginning of 2025, then we can launch our cars," VinFast Asia CEO Pham Sanh Chau said here in an interaction.

"This year, we will launch two products," he said when asked about the product launch plans of the company in India. Stressing that the premium SUVs VF 7 and VF 6 will accelerate the adoption of EVs in India, Chau said, "We come with a long-term vision, with the factory being constructed, with a network of dealers and workshops, and also with our network of charging points, we want to come, not to sell the

car, but want to build the whole infrastructure."

When asked if the company is seeking to avail of benefits from India's new EV policy aimed to woo foreign companies to set up manufacturing units in India, he said, "When we entered here (in India) at that time there was no scheme that the government was working at the moment, we entered here with strong determination to stay long term." Chau, however, said VinFast has been in discussion with the government for its project to be considered for benefits under the policy as the company would like to sell imported completely built unit (CBU) electric vehicles in India as well.

RBL Bank Q3 net at ₹47 cr

**AFTER NAVI MUMBAI POLICE DIVERTS GUARDS FOR COLDFPLAY EVENT
Elgaar Parishad accused lodged at Taloja jail warn of hunger strike**

ACTIVISTS ARRESTED IN THE Elgaar Parishad case have threatened to go on an indefinite hunger strike from Monday, following a decision that for four days starting from January 18, police guards of the Navi Mumbai commissionerate will be deployed for the security of the Coldplay concert at the DY Patil stadium in Navi Mumbai.

The Navi Mumbai police commissionerate has informed the Taloja Central Jail, where the male Elgaar Parishad accused are lodged. The jail was informed that all guards are deployed at the Coldplay concert which is to take place on Saturday, Sunday and Tuesday and hence, guards will not be available to produce

undertrials for court hearings or other scheduled visits like the hospital.

Lawyer Sumit Gadling, son of lawyer Surendra Gadling, accused in the Elgaar Parishad case, said on behalf of the Elgaar Parishad accused, a letter was written to the jail superintendent, stating that 'deploying security guards, who are reserved for the needs of the prisoners, to an entertainment event like the Coldplay concert is a violation of the fundamental rights and human rights of all prisoners.'

Gadling's letter to the authorities seeks that the Navi Mumbai police commissionerate withdraw the decision to divert the guards for jail duty to be sent to the concert. If the notice is not withdrawn and the guards are not made available by Sunday, all Elgaar Parishad prisoners will begin a hunger strike starting Monday, the letter states.

The Navi Mumbai police said that 1,000 police personnel will be deployed for duty at the concert.

Gadling had previously approached court stating that while a government resolution was issued stating that 239 police guards of the personnel force will be reserved for the jail, they are regularly deployed other duties like VIP handover.

An official from the Navi Mumbai police said that since most of the force will be on duty at the concert, the jail has been informed to make arrangements for production of accused via video-conference, and others with specific court directions will be produced before the court on Monday.

Speeding tanker mows down man, hunt on for driver

Mumbai: The DB Marg police are on the lookout for an unidentified person after a speeding tanker allegedly ran over a 28-year-old man in south Mumbai, causing his death.

The deceased has been identified as Suraj Sheikh, a native of West Bengal who was staying with his family at an under-construction site in Byculla. "It was his week off on Thursday, which is why he decided to visit his cousin, Lalchand Sheikh, in Grant Road," said a police officer.

Around 11.30am, Sheikh and his friend Saad Shah, started for Grant Road. After visiting Lalchand, they were returning when Sheikh was knocked down by a speeding tanker. Sheikh sustained injuries but managed to get up and started walking, after which he suddenly collapsed on the road. Sheikh took a rickshaw to Nair Hospital. He was rushed to Nair Hospital where he died during treatment. **ENS**

ATTACK ON SAIF ALI KHAN
Accused caught on CCTV buying phone cover near Dadar rly stn

Police may record statement of person who sold phone cover to actor's attacker

THE MAN who allegedly attacked actor Saif Ali Khan inside his residence in Bandra roomed around Dadar in central Mumbai hours after the incident and even purchased a mobile phone cover from a shop, the police team investigating the case have concluded after tracking the intruder's movements.

Sources in the police department said after being spotted in the Laxmi Junction area in Bandra, the accused likely boarded local train, travelled to Dadar, purchased a mobile phone cover from a shop named I3A near platform 1 of Dadar (West) railway station, walked outside the Suvidha showroom, and headed towards Kambharkhana.

The accused's movements have been recorded on the CCTV camera at the mobile shop at 8.04 am, sources added. The police may record the statement of the person who sold the phone cover to the accused.

The accused, believed to be in his early 30s, snuck into Khan's 11th-floor apartment between 2 am and 2.30 am on Thursday, allegedly demanding Rs 1 crore, injured the family's nanny, and later attacked Khan with a knife six times before escaping.

Khan, who is reportedly, was rushed to Lilavati Hospital in an ambulance, where he underwent surgery. Senior doctors say he is stable and out of danger.

The police have already recorded the statement of Khan's wife Kareena Kapoor Khan and other staff present at the crime scene who witnessed the attack.

Attacker was in 2-km radius of crime scene for nearly 6 hours, shows CCTV footage

IN AN embarrassment to the Bandra police in Mumbai, CCTV footage has now revealed that the man who attacked actor Saif Ali Khan at his Bandra residence early on Thursday was in the vicinity for nearly six hours after the incident.

A CCTV grab shows that the accused was at Bandra railway station at 8 am. The Bandra railway station is just 1.6 km from Sagar Sharan building, where Khan stays with his family, in Bandra (West).

A police officer said that the initial hours after a crime are critical to an investigation and if the image of the accused had been circulated among the railway police,

the Crime Branch, and other police teams immediately, there was a greater chance that he would have been arrested within the first few hours itself.

CCTV footage shows that the accused was in Dadar in central Mumbai, the next railway station after Bandra on the West line, till 9.30 am even as the police were scrambling to catch him. By the time his image was circulated among various police units, some officers suspect he may have gone into hiding.

A police officer said that even if the local police were alerted about the incident two hours later and it took them two hours to get the footage, they should have had the accused's image by 6am. Had the image been circulated among railway police and other police

staff, there was a higher probability of him being nabbed before getting the time to go into hiding, the officer added.

Within hours of the incident, the police had found CCTV footage where the accused can be seen entering the building and leaving. While going up, he had covered his face. Later, the police found a screen grab of the accused while he left the building. The police also found footage of him changing his shirt.

"All teams want to nab the accused first. This can lead to them working at cross purposes. At least in such a sensitive and high-profile case, the priority should have been to share all possible information with all police units so that the accused could be nabbed soon. A failure to do so may have cost the police," a senior officer said.

Bullet train to run at 250 kmph inside tunnels: Ashwini Vaishnav

CARRIVING OUT an inspection of the progress of the bullet train project in Mumbai, Union Minister for Railways Ashwini Vaishnav said once complete, the trains will run at speeds of 250 km/h inside the tunnels, including in the portions where they are passing under the sea.

The bullet train project includes construction of a 2.1 km-long tunnel, which will feature the first-ever 70m underwater tunnel in Maharashtra that will be located between Bandra Kuria Complex (BKC) and Shilphata in Thane.

Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) required for this underground work are expected to arrive in Mumbai within the next three months. Vivek Kumar Gupta, managing director of the National High-Speed Rail Corporation Ltd (NHSRCL), said the arrival of these machines will significantly accelerate the progress of the project. These TBMs are being sourced from Germany and their assembly is currently underway.

Of the 21km of tunneling required for the bullet train project, 16km will be constructed using TBMs, while the remaining 5km will be done using the New Austrian Tunneling Method (NATM). As of now, 2km of the tunnel has already been completed using the NATM.

Additionally, a segment casting yard has been set up at Mahape in Navi Mumbai to support the tunnel construction. The yard will produce 77,000 segments required for the entire tunnel. Officials said various cranes, gantries, and automated machines are being used to streamline operations at the casting yard.

Fire breaks out at Grant Road

Mumbai: A fire broke out at a four-storey residential unit on Grant Road on Saturday morning. No casualties were reported.

The incident was reported at the Patel Mansion. According to preliminary information furnished by the BMC, the fire broke out inside a residential unit located in the third floor of the building. The Mumbai Fire Brigade deployed four fire engines alongside three jumbo tankers to douse the flames. **ENS**
